## Volunteering Matters:

Sizewell C: The work to resurface sections of the B1122 is finished. The Sizewell Team informs us that next, work continues with a reduction in the speed limit to improve safety and reduce noise and vibrations in advance of the Sizewell Link Road being built. From *May 20<sup>th</sup>* 2024, a 30mph speed limit will be in place for all vehicles between Yoxford and Lovers Lane in Leiston.
