If you haven't already, you'll be seeing the coming year's Council Tax Bill sliding its way through your letter box. With the continuing rise in so many day to day costs, times remain uncertain and financially tough for many. At its meeting in January, the Parish Council voted to keep its request for **Precept at a 0%** and decided again, that it would need to dip into its savings to meet its financial

obligations. A rainy day fund is useful for a parish council too!
